



Peter Pan sculpture by Sir George Frampton based on J.M Barrie's title character.

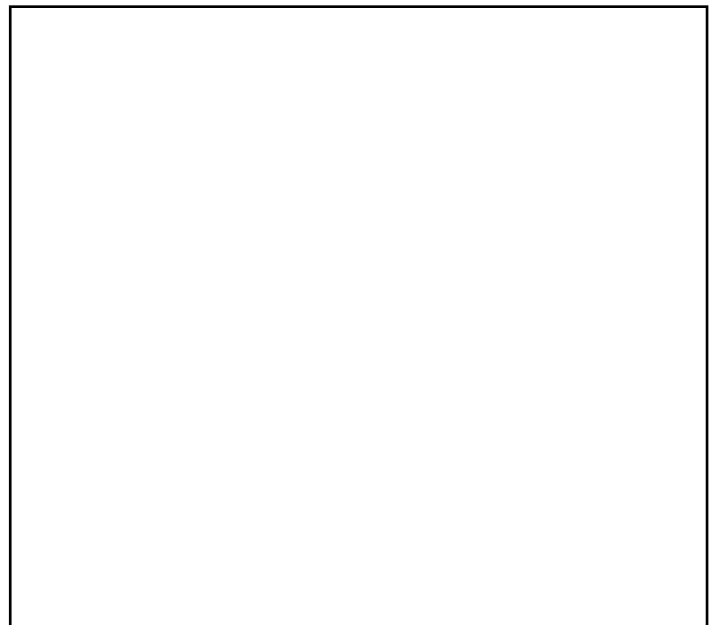
Erected in 1928 and made from cast bronze, this Grade II listed sculpture features not only the 'boy who never grew up' but also fairies and woodland creatures.
