

The Curious Compass Palm House Plant Hunt

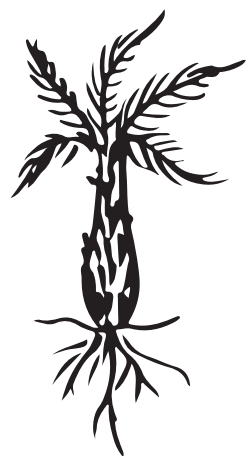
Explore 5 continents in the Palm House with this map and find special plants.

The Palm House is a giant compass! Each of the Palm House porches matches a compass direction. The main entrance faces north.

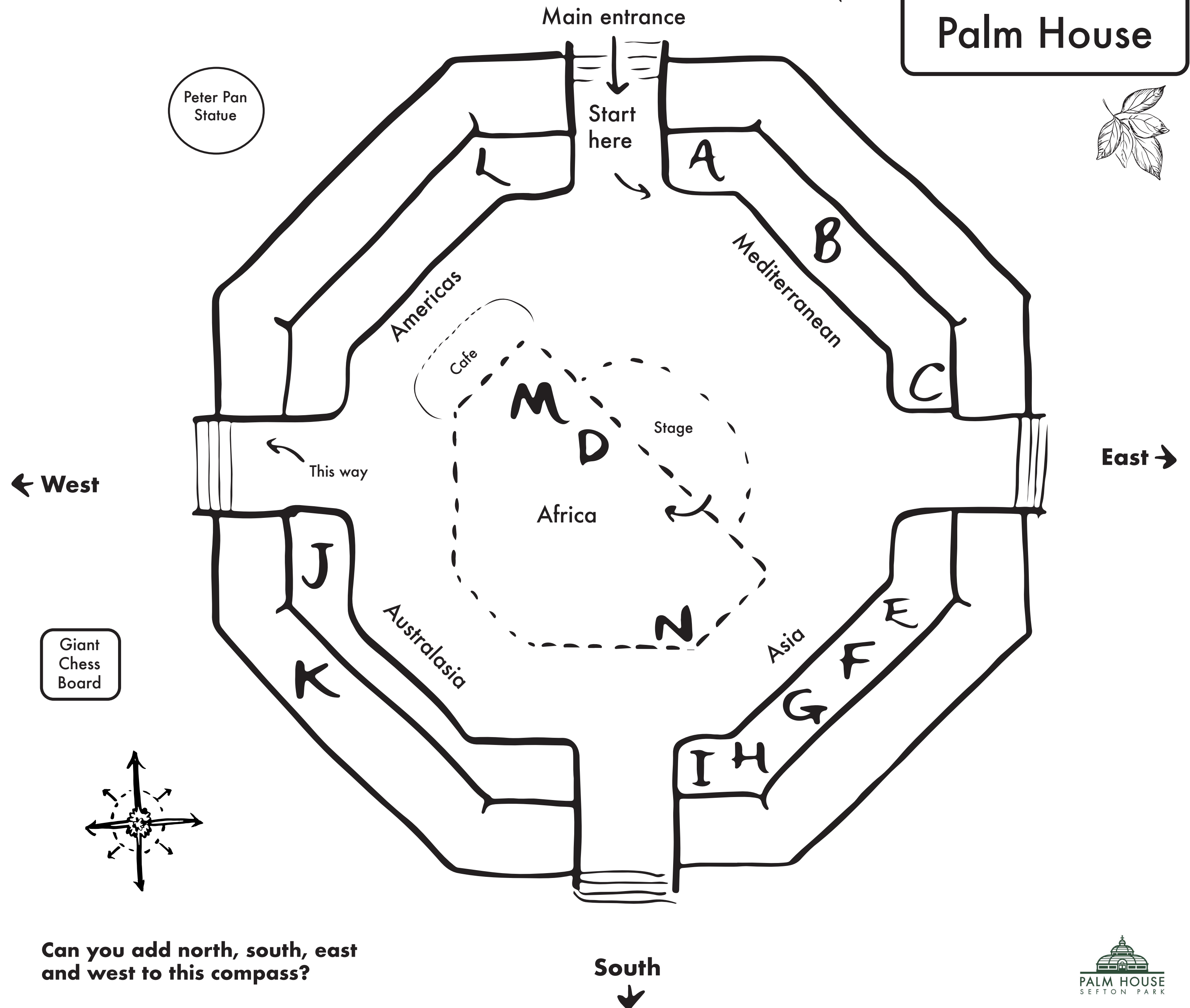

Plant names

We usually call a plant by its common name. Did you know that they also have a special scientific name? The scientific names are in Latin and usually include 2 words. The first word is the plant's family name, called the genus. The second word is the species - that plant's own name. A Swedish biologist named Carl Linnaeus invented this way to name plants.
